
We thought we would drop you a note to let you know that our excitement to get started with the install of Enviro-Save in our brand new corporate car - 2003 Cadillac CTS has finally come due. We finally reached the first oil change through break-in and we installed Enviro-Save just a few weeks ago. With the accuracy of the onboard computer tracking - it keeps meaningful records of the cars operation. I tracked 13 tanks of gas since purchasing the car. We averaged 19.4, 19.5 and 19.6 in City driving with the average being 19.5. When we drove exclusive on highway trips, for example, from Point Roberts to Seattle many times, the average over the 6 trips was very consistent - 21.9, 22.0, 22.1 for an average of 22.0 mpg highway.

After the installation, we followed the instructions to drive the car and not shut it down for the first hour. This first tank of gas including this non-stop running of the engine and yet the computer said 21.6 for the average City mpg first tank full. That is a 10% improvement.

We then proceeded to fill the tank for the second time - and we had a trip to do that was still a combination of both city and highway - but mostly highway. After the 138 mile trip - I was curious to see if we reached the pure highway number which was 22.0 mpg and I was shocked to access the computer to find the fuel average to be 25.9. That is a 15% fuel mileage improvement on a brand new car. Wow!!

Thanks for such an amazing product --let's tell the world! I can't wait to see the pure highway number - it may break 30mpg.
